PARASHAT VA'ERA Exodus 6:2–9:35

God tells Moses to ask Pharaoh for permission for the Israelites to depart Egypt. Moses and Aaron request the freedom of their people, but Pharaoh refuses. As a consequence, terrible plagues are set upon Egypt. The waters of the Nile turn to blood; the land is filled with frogs and swarms of insects; then there is the death of Egyptian livestock; and later there is destructive hail. These plagues are sent to punish Pharaoh and to force him to free the Israelites.
